

In this article we will share with you some of the Italian UNESCO sites that you can visit next summer.

First of all, what is UNESCO?

UNESCO means United Nations, Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization.

Now you may think... what does it mean? UNESCO's mission is to contribute to the building of a culture of peace, eradication of poverty, sustainable development and intercultural dialogue through education, sciences, culture, information and communication.

UNESCO has a lot of wonderful sites all around the world and they are all different from each other, but, in this article, we'll talk about the Italian ones.

Italy has 58 UNESCO sites! 53 are cultural and 5 are natural. We'll talk about 5 of them.

O City of Verona: UNESCO's sites can be a whole city! In fact, the city of Verona is one of them. Verona is situated in northern part of Italy in Veneto. It is known for being the city of Romeo and Juliet from Shakespeare. It even has Juliet's balcony! The city is beautiful and has many cool monuments.



O Historic centre of Florence: Florence is one of the very first Italian UNESCO World Heritage sites and the city was founded in the 59 BC! That's a lot of time ago! Florence is situated in the central part of Italy in Tuscany. This city gave birth to essential figures in literature and art of the 13<sup>th</sup> century: Michelangelo Buonarotti, Petrarch, Boccaccio, and Leonardo DaVinci.

Florence's historical centre can be considered a living museum.



O Archaeological Areas of Pompeii: Pompeii is an archaeological site situated in south Italy. In the year 79 AD, the Vesuvius volcano in southern Italy erupted and buried the surrounding area under layers of ash and rock! At the time Pompeii was an urbanized town of 25000 people just recovering from a recent earthquake. The site was then discovered in the 16<sup>th</sup> century and became accessible to the public in the mid-18<sup>th</sup> century.



• Venice and its lagoon: Venice, in north Italy, was founded in the 5<sup>th</sup> century and over the centuries it became a major maritime power spread over 118 small islands! The entire city is an architectural masterpiece. Almost every little island had its own settlement, town, fishing village and artisan village. Venice and its lagoon are a unique cultural heritage and is one of the symbols of Italian power and majesty.



Villa d'Este in Tivoli: Villa d'Este is a masterpiece of the Italian garden. It includes an impressive collection of fountains, nymphs, grottoes and plays of water and music. The palazzo d'Este is also characterized by an elegant façade. So, the Villa d'Este in Tivoli, with its palace and garden, is one of the most remarkable and comprehensive illustrations of Renaissance culture.

It all started nearly 70 years ago in Mexico, when a man called Julian Santana Barrera decided to leave his family to go and live lonely in an Isle, near to Mexico City. For now, everything seems normal, but one day, Julian finds a dead girl in the lake, drowned.

The fact that he couldn't save the girl marked him, and since then, he was not the same. Many people say that the girl never actually existed, it was all in the mind of the poor Julian, who was driving crazy, due to his loneliness. Not much time later, he found a doll in the same place as the dead body, so he decided to hang it on a tree, to be respectfull. From that moment he felt haunted from the girl's spirit and started hanging more and more crippled, dirty, broken doll, to please the spirit.

But the more dolls Julian got, the more he drove insane, thinking that every doll he hung, was haunted.

One day, after 50 years of obsessive doll collectioning, in 2001, Julian was found dead, drowned in the same place as he found the girl. From 2001, Isla de las Munecas has begun to be a tourist attraction, where people can hang more dolls.

Many visitors argue that they could hear the dolls whispering at each other, and move. The fact that due to time and humidity the dolls are deteriorating makes that place even more disturbing and terryfing.

Even if there are thousands of dolls, we can stilll recognize the first doll that Julian Santana Barrera hung, the girl's doll.

You can only visit this place during day, and only if you rent a boat to get there. You need to be careful, in fact there are some fakes Isla de las Munecas, made to catch visitors.

Julian was a farmer for the frist half of his life. He had sons and a wife. He was a neighbour of the Barrio de la Asunción, where he was used to go drink pulque, an alcholic beverage, made with agave, after selling his products. That's was his life until he began preaching the Bible due to superstitions which led to him being expelled from the sector of farming.

This is probably what lead him to leave everything to leave a lonely life in his Isle.

It's still unknown how he died, the only thing we know is that he drowned, he could have commited suicide.

In many countries of the world, Labour Day is celebrated on 1<sup>st</sup> May. Association of the Order of American Knights of Labour.

In 1866, the first law of eight working hours per day was passed in Chicago, a law that came into force only the following year, on May 1, 1867, the day on which a major demonstration was organized, with at least ten thousand participants.

The conquest of the eight working hours, which began on May 1, 1867 only in the state of Illinois, had a subsequent slow and gradual expansion



throughout the United States. Still in 1882, in the city of New York, an important protest was organized on September 5, while two years later, in 1884, in a similar American demonstration, the Knights of Labour themselves passed a resolution to have the protest event a yearly anniversary, but did not

yet propose an official date in Illinois. The date of Labour Day, May Day, was officially established in Paris on July 20, 1889. It was ratified by

representatives of the European Socialist and Labour Parties who met in the capital French for the Congress of the Second Socialist International.

#### HOPE OF WATER ON MARS

In recent days NASA has made a tweet showing two photos taken by Perseverance in which stratified rocks are seen that could provide new clues about the presence of water in the past of Mars.

The photographs were captured by the probe inside the *Jezero crater*, the area where the NASA rover is moving. Rocks like those photographed by Perseverance are characterized by layers that we often find in underwater rocks, here on Earth.

They could contain important clues to make us understand even better what the planet must have been like so many years ago.

#### JEZERO'S PAST

Mars has got an atmosphere dense enough to support the water on its surface. The *Jezero River Delta* suffered late-stage flooding events that carried rocks and debris from the highlands well outside the crater.



A reservoir of water has been discovered on Mars, in the *Valles Marineris*. It is a vast system of valleys, about the size of the Netherlands, located in the equatorial zone of the red planet and considered the "*Martian Grand Canyon*". It is not the first time that water has been found on Mars, but it has always been detected in the form of ice in the polar regions.

We all might think that it is amazing that there is water or life on Mars and that from these effects we can create life forms and a new generation totally different from ours.

# RINASCENTE

**Rinascente S.p.A.**, commercially known as **Rinascente**, is a chain of department stores founded in Italy at the beginning of the '900 based in Milan, owned by the Thai Centrali Group.

Rinascente is present in Italy in eight cities: Milan, Turin, Monza, Florence, Rome, Cagliari, Catania and Palermo.

#### THE ORIGINS: THE WAREHOUSES OF THE BOCCONI BROTHERS

In 1865 the brothers Luigi and Ferdinando Bocconi opened in Via Santa Radegonda in Milan the first Italian store of ready-made clothes.

The following year they employed more than a hundred workers who made ready-made clothes for men. Between 1872 and 1876 they opened other shops in Rome in Via del Corso, Genoa, Trieste, Palermo and Turin.



The Second World War caused serious damage to the company: the branches of Genoa and Cagliari were destroyed, the store in Piazza Duomo was practically razed to the ground. Only one Rinascente store in Rome and 37 UPIM warehouses were still operating. In order not to interrupt

sales, the City of Milan leases to Rinascente three large halls in the Region's Palace in Mercanti street.



On 11 June 2020, Rinascente launched its online store, a project that saw the investment of 20 million euros in three years.

Rinascente is the best place to go shopping, not only for the quality of its garments, but also for the beauty and care that are found in the store. The windows, especially during the Christmas period, are real works.

## **IQBAL MASIH**


In this article I'll talk about a young boy that was a child labourer in **Pakistan.** 

But why am I going to talk about Iqbal? I chose to talk about him because he was an activist who campaigned against abusive child labour in Pakistan and became one of their symbols.

Now I'll tell his story:

Iqbal Masih was a Pakistan boy, born in 1983 at Murdike in a poor Catholic family; but at the age of four he was sent to work to pay off they're debts. He got up very early to go to work, where he and most of the other kids were tightly tied with chains to prevent them to escape. At the age of ten, Iqbal escaped from the factory and ran to the police station to report what was happening, but the police just sent him back to the factory without helping.

One day, in 1992 he escaped again with other kids and assisted to the celebration for **the** 



**liberty day organized by BLLF**. Iqbal hears for the first time about kids' rights and about kids that work like slavery and illegally. Iqbal then decided to tell his story too. His story became viral all around the world. He then started to tell his story everywhere and on the television. He soon became **the symbol of child labour**.

He said he wanted to become a lawyer to help other kids, so he started studying. He would have become one. Sadly, in 1995 on the 16<sup>th</sup> of April, on easter, he gets shot while riding a bike with his cousins in his native city Murdike. He was only 12.

#### Sanction by the British Government to Abramovich



Chelsea owner Roman Abramovich is on the list of Russian oligarchs sanctioned by the British government, as a measure of repression for what is happening in Ukraine.

The Russian billionaire - who in recent days has announced the will to sell Chelsea, announcing that the proceeds of the sale will be donated to the victims of the war in Ukraine - will be frozen all assets.

"There can be no safe places for those who supported Putin's attack on Ukraine," said Prime Minister Boris Johnson. In addition to Abramovich, the British government has sanctioned six other oligarchs: magnate Oleg Deripaska, the number one energy giant of the state Gazprom and Rosneft, Aleksei Miller and Igor Secin, as well as bankers Andre Kostin and Dmitri Lebedev, and Nikolai Tokarev, president of the public giant of pipelines Transnef.

#### **The implications for Chelsea**

The club may have a special license for the day-to-day, but the sale of the company has been blocked at the time, so as to avoid that Abramovich could make any kind of profit from the sale of the club.

Chelsea can continue to pay players and staff, but cannot sign new contracts. So Antonio Rudiger, Andreas Christensen and Cesar Azpilicueta, who have contracts expiring on June 30, will not be able to renew with the club.

In addition, Chelsea will not be able to do transfer operations. Tickets may not be sold, but only those already in possession of the subscription will have access to Stamford Bridge.

Tickets already purchased are valid, but no new tickets can be purchased. The sale of jerseys or other merchandising was also blocked at Chelsea. Abramovich was also notified of the ban on entering the United Kingdom.

# "AI" - ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

hen we talk about Artificial Intelligence, we immediately think of cutting-edge technologies, robots able to understand and decide the actions to be taken and of a futuristic world in which machines and men coexist.

Artificial Intelligence and its uses are much more real than you can imagine and are now used in different areas of everyday life.

As it is defined today, *Artificial Intelligence* was born with the advent of computers and its date of birth is set as 1956.

Just this year, in fact, we spoke for the first time about Artificial Intelligence during a conference that was held in America and that saw the participation of some of the most important names of what would later be called Artificial Intelligence. During this historic conference, some programs already capable of making some logical reasoning were presented, especially related to mathematics.

**The Logic Theorist program**, developed by two computer scientists, Allen Newell and Herbert Simon, was in fact able to prove some theorems of mathematics starting from certain information.

In 1955, Simon and Newell had discussions about teaching machines to think. These discussions gave rise to a program that could prove mathematical theorems such as Bertrand Russell's Alfred North Whitehead and Principia Mathematica.



It had to be specifically designed to mimic the problem-solving skills exposed by real people. The result was to be a program that could think like a real human mathematician. However, to make the program work, Simon and Newell would need the help of a computer programmer. This program represents each problem as

a tree model, it would attempt to solve it by selecting the branch that would most likely lead to the correct conclusion.

I think AI is very important in our lives.

### **BASKETBALL**



Basketball is a team sport commonly known as basketball. In this sport there are two teams composed of 5 players: according to the rules of basketball, the aim of the game is to make as many shots as possible, each of which will determine a score. Let's retrace the history of basketball, through the main stages of its evolution.

#### The origins of basketball

Unlike baseball, whose origins are uncertain, basketball is safe. Due to the harsh winters of the state of Massachuttes, the head of the physical education department of the private Christian college of the YMCA International Training School in Springfield, Luther Halsey Gulick, asked Professor of Canadian origin James Naismith, to find an activity that students could have done in the gym. Gulick in particular demanded a game in closed places, easy to learn, with few occasions of contact, the cost of which did not weigh on the expenses of the school.

#### Basketball history

Legend has it that Naismith developed the idea of the game of basketball after throwing a paper ball into the basket; then he nailed two baskets with the bottom closed to the opposite balconies of the gym, established a few simple rules and used a leather ball. More



realistically, Naismith found inspiration from a game he had known in his childhood in Ontario, "Duck-on-a-Rock" (the duck on a rock), in which the main rule was the parabola shot of a stone. He also drew on older games, such as the Aztec Tlachtli and the Mayan Pok-Ta-Pok.

The name of the game, taken from the English term basketball meaning basket, was suggested by one of James Naismith's pupils, Frank Mahan, following the inventor's refusal to call it Naismithball.

# The main rules of Basketball, created by Naismith

- You have to use a round balloon, which can only be touched with your hands.
- You cannot walk with the ball in your hands the players.
- Players can position themselves and move anywhere in the field.
- Physical contact between players is not allowed.

#### 9th Parachute Assault Regiment "Col Moschin"

The Italian special forces are the units of the Italian armed forces specially designated to conduct special operations.

Members of the Italian Special Forces are called raiders.

In Italy, the Special Forces of the Armed Forces are: the 9 and the Aves Special Operations Helicopter Division, the Army Air Force.

The 9th Parachute Assault Regiment "Col Moschin" is the unit of raiders of the Italian Army, the precursor since 1954 of the Italian special forces units.

The base of the Regiment is in Livorno at the barracks "Vannucci". The history of the Regiment may be associated with that of some Arditi units of the First World War, such as the IX Assault Department.

In Italy the Special Forces are those military units called to develop special operations, or unconventional military operations with strategic effect such as: the contrast of insurrectional and terrorist activities, the release of hostages, raids against enemy targets.



The candidates to the department are chosen through a selective process lasting 21 days, at the training centre BAI (Base Training Raiders) of Pisa; subsequently they are trained through a long training cycle lasting about two years.

Selective phase (7 weeks) is structured in pre-selection and internship selection. The initial pre-selection provides several physical tests:

- plane travel: 2000 m within 8'20';
- bar pull-ups: minimum 10 in 1' (prone handle);
- push-ups (push-ups/push-ups): minimum 30 in 1';
- parallel bending: minimum 10 in 1';
- abdominal bending: minimum 40 in 1';
- rope climb (\*\*): 4 m within 1'45" (any technique);
- high jump: minimum 120 cm (any technique);

# GIVE HIM A HOPE The Blind Side



production of this film was started in 2008, at the Atlanta International School in the USA.


The Leigh Anne Tuohy part was previously entrusted for Julia Roberts, but refusing, the role was for Sandra Bullock.

The Legend of Zelda is a high fantasy video game series created by Shigeru Miyamoto and Takashi Tezuka in 1986 for the Nintendo Entertainment System. It soon became one of the most successful video game series, selling 107.07 million copies and producing a large number of sequels, which appeared on many of the Kyoto home consoles: Nintendo Entertainment System, Super Nintendo Entertainment System, the various Game Boy, Nintendo 64, Nintendo Gamecube, Nintendo Wii, Nintendo DS, Nintendo 3DS, Nintendo Wii U and Nintendo Switch.

This success has led to the release of several manga and an animated series inspired by it, but rarely these works have crossed the borders of Japan.

The gameplay can be defined as a mix of action, adventure and puzzle.

### **Plot**

The Legendary Triforce in the Sacred Realm The main enemy, an evil wizard named Ganondorf (or Ganon, depending on the episode), determined to take possession of the mystical object called Triforza. He terrorizes the lands of Hyrule by invading them with his hordes of creatures and monsters and taking hostage Princess Zelda, heir to the throne of Hyrule.

In the midst of Ganondorf's misdeeds, Link, the hero chosen by the goddesses, always intervenes. Some games in the main series, however, cannot be represented by this plot: in several Ganondorf is missing, as in Majora's Mask or Phantom Hourglass, while others, such as Majora's Mask himself, are not set in Hyrule.

The games in the series seem set in the medieval era.

### The author

Shigeru Miyamoto, to create the series, was inspired by his exploratory experiences. As a boy he loved to explore the hilly area surrounding his native neighborhood in Kyoto, where he ventured into dense forests with lakes and caves in them.

According to Miyamoto, a significant experience was to find the entrance to a cave in the middle of the forest, which he decided to explore to the end by

lighting himself with a lantern. This greatly influenced Zelda's creation, as cave exploration is a major element of the game.

Zelda's name was inspired by Zelda Sayre Fitzgerald, wife of Francis Scott Fitzgerald.

The name of Link comes precisely from the English word "link", because the character was intended as a link between the player and it.

It is considered one of the most important and acclaimed in the world of video games and most of the titles that compose it are recognized by critics as great masterpieces, considered among the best video games of all time, without forgetting, of course, the original The Legend of Zelda.

Wattpad is a social reading network launched in 2006 and owned by Wattpad Corporation, accessible both via website and application.

The site brings together a multilingual community of writers and readers, free to publish any original content.

Details of the content are requested before publication. The story is catalogued, at the discretion of the author, in a literary genre and classified according to the plot. In the "details of the story" are inserted tags, labels that reflect themes and subgenres of the story, to facilitate the search in the platform of stories similar to their tastes.

It is also possible to attribute copyright to the story.

In 2010, the internal writing competition was born in order to enhance the best stories on the platform. In 2015, the award ceremony was extended to stories written in languages other than English, involving more writers.

Users can enter stories in the contest by adding the hashtag #wattys to the story description, and the year of the contest. Stories written in the competition year or with at least five chapters published in the same year are accepted. The competition usually runs from June to August, with the winners announced the following autumn. The winning stories are promoted on official channels to give them more visibility.

The user can decide to publish a story in full or by inserting a chapter at a time, independently deciding the frequency of the update.

In 2011 Wattpad was nominated in the category "Best e-reader App" for the Best App Ever Awards.

In the same year he won the People's Choice Award as Digital Media at the Canadian Innovation Exchange.

In 2016, she was named "Innovator of the Year" at the Canadian Innovation Exchange. The award is given annually to a company at the forefront of its industry, representing the best of Canadian business.

## TOMMY THILFIGER

Called Thomas Jacob Hilfiger, he was born on March 24, 1951, and is an

American designer known for the brand "Tommy Hilfiger".

As a boy he founded a fashion place that sold jeans, especially elephant's paw and was in New York.

Over time it expanded in the sense that it began to produce perfumes and more women's clothing.



Graduated, he did not want to continue his studies but to undertake in the fashion world working in brown's warehouses in New York where he designed "ad personam" garments such as jeans.

Hilfiger continues to design clothes for the ten stores he has scattered throughout the northern part of the state of New York, and in 1979 Hilfiger moved with his wife Susie, from whom he is now separated, to New York City.



Despite receiving job offers as an assistant designer from stylists such as Calvin Klein and Perry Ellis, and despite financial woes, he rejects proposals to pursue bigger goals.

Hilfiger is now an established designer all over the world, and in 1998 he hosted the singer Aaliyah at his Fashion Show in Jamaica. In 2000 signs of crisis: for the first time sales fell and a rebranding was decided. In 2002, CBS, an American television channel, broadcast a reality show, The Cut, in which sixteen contestants compete for a design position in Tommy Hilfiger's company. In the end Chris Cortez wins.

He was accused of spilling his companions' drinks on the ground since he was drunk. At the end of the evening, he was dragged away by his bodyguards. He is still alive; he is 70 years old and lives in New York where he has been designing clothes for 10 stores since he was a boy.


#### 2. PIG

### FREDDIE MERCURY

Freddie Mercury, pseudonym of Farrokh Bulsara, was a very famous songwriter.

He was born in the 5<sup>th</sup> September 1946 in Zanzibar from Bomi Rustomoji (his father) and Jer Bulsara (his mother).

His father was a famous politician, so during his childhood he moved out often, he completed his elementary studies at Bombay, In India, and ultimated them in England.

Initially, his future plans did not involve music; in fact he signed up for the Institute of Arts Ealing, and he got his graduation there, in Art and Design.

A while after Freddie started showing interest for the world of music, he started showing his piano skills when he joined a band called "Ibex", the first of two other important bands in his life.

The band was composed by: Miller Bersin, the guitarist, John Taylor, the bassist and Mick Smith, the drummer.

In the last months of 1969, after Smith's place was replaced by Richard Thompson, Freddie suggested to rename the band "Wreckage".

After that in 1970 he still left the band to join another one called the "Sour Milk Tea".

This band instead was formed by LoChris Dummett, Jeremy Gallop e Paul Milne London, however it didn't take longer for its member to start a fight and decide to separate the group.

After taking separate ways from his companions, Freddie Mercury met two people that would have changed his life: Brian May and Roger Taylor. Freddie Mercury died in 24th November 1991 in London.

The cause of death was AIDS.



### THE QUEEN

"The Queen" formed in 1970 in The well-known Freddie Mercury, who sang and played piano, Brian May, Roger Taylor and John Deacon.

At the beginning the band was influenced by progressive rock, hard rock and heavy metal, but it gradually changed in arena rock and pop rock.

Before "The Queen" May and Taylor were in another band, "Smile", which fell apart after the singer's release in the 70s, Mercury entered the and in the same year, Deacon the year later.

Bohemian Rapsody became a revolution in music, not only it was 6 minutes long but it was also divided into 5 parts!

Their popularity increased, in particular in 1986 when Mercury gave his last concert, and continued his solo career.

The Queen band is still popular in music culture and, nowadays, they're one of the best-selling music artists. The awards that they received are numberless!!

Some of our personal favorite songs are "Killer queen" and "Bohemian Rhapsody".


# The Robin Hood Festival


